What to be prepared for: Please dress appropriately for weather, including possibly windy conditions, and wet, muddy trails.

What to bring: Camera, binocular

Join scientist and educator Sarah Ferner from San Francisco Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve for a short walk near the edge of China Camp's tidal salt marsh during one of the highest high tides of the year—a King Tide. We will learn about the marsh, scientific research occurring there, and what king tides can teach us about sea level rise. Bring your camera to participate in California King Tide Initiative's citizen science photo monitoring. The walk will proceed rain or shine because stormy weather creates an even more dramatic scene!
