

Mudslides and downed trees have resulted in the closure of Shoreline Trail from the intersection at Peacock Gap Trail to the intersection with Miwok Fire Road

As a result of the recent severe and persistent storms, many sections of our trail network have suffered damage, including downed trees, landslides, plugged culverts, erosion and drainage issues. This damage represents a safety concern, requiring these closures. The FOCC trail maintenance team has set these repairs as a priority. The repair of the major landslide on shoreline trail has been assessed by engineers and will require heavy equipment, many tons of materials, and many hardworking volunteers. We are awaiting approval from the state, and hope to begin repairs soon.

Remember, China Camp State Park receives no funds from the State. The repair work is performed by dedicated volunteers, and all expenses are incurred by member-supported Friends of China Camp.
