

PARENTAL PERMISSION FOR JUVENILE CAMPING

China Camp State Park Backranch Meadows Campground

A permission slip from a parent or legal guardian is necessary for a juvenile (14 to 17 years of age) to camp in State Parks without responsible adult supervision. It lets us know that you know where your child is, what he or she is doing, and that you are consenting to the activity. It also allows us to contact you in case of an emergency.

The permission slip must include the name and age of the juvenile, the dates the juvenile is permitted to camp, and the signature, printed name, address, and phone number of the parent or legal guardian. Juveniles under fourteen years of age are not permitted to camp without adult supervision. This form is provided for your convenience – you may be called to verify your consent.

CAMPING RULES AND CONDITIONS FOR JUVENILES

China Camp State Park Backranch Meadows Campground

1. Each juvenile camping at Backranch Meadows Campground must have a signed permission slip from a parent or guardian. It must include the name and age of the juvenile, the dates the juvenile is permitted to camp, and the signature, printed name, address, and phone number of the parent or legal guardian. Forged notes may be considered as providing false information to peace officers. In addition, all juveniles will be required to read and sign China Camp State Park's Camping Rules and Conditions for Juveniles form.
2. Each "visiting" juvenile must check in at the Entrance Station and read and sign a Camping Rules and Conditions for Juveniles form. Visiting juveniles are required to leave the park by sunset.
3. Quiet hours are from 10 PM to 6 AM. Radios must be turned off and talking must be kept low. At all times, noise should never be so loud that it disturbs other campers.
4. Alcohol shall not be possessed by anyone under 21 years old.
5. In addition to the rules stated above, you are responsible to know and abide by all park rules and regulations.

Any violation of the above rules and conditions may result in eviction, citation, or both; and your parents will be notified.
