

2020 CAMPGROUND REGULATIONS

Effective June 2020

- **If you or anyone in your party is exhibiting symptoms such as coughing, shortness of breath, or fever, please cancel your reservation through Reserve California.**
- **You are required to wear a mask at all times when using the common areas of the campground. This includes the pathways, parking lot, bathrooms, and water spigot areas. You do not need to wear a mask when you are in your own campsite.**
- **Please stay at least 6 ft away from other individuals that are not in your household at all times.**
- **For every vehicle associated with the reservation, please print out a copy of your Reserve California reservation confirmation and bring it with you to use in place of a vehicle tag. It should include the first and last name of the reservation holder, site number, date due in and date due out.**
 - **If a printer is unavailable, please hand write the above information on a piece of paper in large print and place it on your dashboard when in the park.**

- **No more than 8 people are allowed per campsite. If you have 2 or more campsites reserved, we ask that if visiting other sites that no more than 8 people occupy a site at a time.**
- **No temporary visitors are allowed in the campground. Everyone who enters the campground must be spending the night.**
 - If you would like to visit with someone for the day, please leave the campground and visit with them in one of the park's day use areas such as the Village.
- **We do not supply soap or hand sanitizer in the bathrooms. Please bring your own hand soap, hand sanitizer, and cleaning supplies with you.**
 - It is also a good idea to bring something to put toiletries in while you're in the restroom to avoid putting them directly on surfaces.
- **Optional: Bring a tablecloth to cover the picnic table as an additional sanitary layer.**
